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Outcomes

Center-based educators who completed Getting Ready training were better equipped to **build strong partnerships with families**.

As a result of participating in Getting Ready, **center-based educators** were:

- ✓ **80%** more skilled in **communicating** with families
- ✓ **85%** more skilled in **collaborating** with families
- ✓ **85%** more skilled at **setting goals** (child and/or family goals) with families
